



Syringe Use Instructions

Begin using syringes enclosed to keep food/debris out of sockets/holes around the 5th day after surgery. Fill the syringe with warm tap water. Use finger to pull cheek back. Squirt syringe past last tooth where tooth was extracted. Use at least one syringe full for each socket/hole. Need to rinse after each meal and need to continue to rinse until sockets/holes close up which is typically two to three weeks. Call with any increase in pain or swelling which would be abnormal at this point in your healing.
